1. Who we are

These terms apply to every purchase of a module, path, live group lab, programme or residency from AI for Her, a trading name of ESleeswijk Consultancy B.V., registered with the Dutch Chamber of Commerce under KvK 42034470.

2. What you buy

A single module gives you lifetime access to that module. A full path gives you access to all four modules in that path. A live group lab, the Next Professional programme and The Residency include scheduled live sessions with a limited number of seats.

3. Prices and payment

All prices are stated in USD and are exclusive of taxes; applicable taxes are calculated at checkout. Payment is due before access is granted, unless a payment schedule has been agreed in writing.

4. Reserving a seat

Reserving a seat costs nothing and holds your place. Dates are confirmed by email and payment is requested only once your date is set. If you do not confirm within the period stated in that email, the seat is released.

5. Cancellation and refunds

Self-paced modules and paths can be refunded within 14 days of purchase if you have completed less than one module. Live seats can be cancelled up to 14 days before the first session for a full refund, and up to 7 days before for a credit towards a later date.

6. Rescheduling by us

If a live session cannot take place, you receive either a new date or a full refund of the affected part of the programme.

7. Your material

Course material is licensed to you personally. You may use it in your own work. You may not resell, publish or distribute it, or use it to run training for others, without written permission.

8. Results

We teach a method and we assess your work honestly. We cannot guarantee a specific job, income or outcome.

9. Liability

Our liability is limited to the amount you paid for the relevant module, path or programme. AI output must always be checked by you before it is used or sent.

10. Applicable law

Dutch law applies. Disputes are submitted to the competent court in the Netherlands. Questions about these terms can be sent by email and are answered within five working days.
